The Launch of the Greenhaven Campaign: A new Website and Economic Development Vision/Plan

Decatur, GA - In recognition of the beginning of the Georgia General Assembly session for 2016, Concerned Citizens for Cityhood of South DeKalb Inc. (CCCSD) is launching its campaign for approval of a public referendum for the City of Greenhaven. The Campaign or the "Greenhaven movement" is immediately putting forth two important components in the beginning of a series of actions to help residents, legislators, businesses and other citizens make their decisions about Greenhaven. These two components are the Greenhaven Economic Development Vision/Plan and the Greenhaven website.

The Greenhaven Economic Development Vision/Plan is a five-phase approach that combines several practices and perspectives.
